- Trainee Pharmacist Recruitment foundation trainee pharmacists for the 2025-26 training year can only be recruited through Oriel, and the deadline for applications is 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024. As most foundation trainee pharmacists from 2025 on will register as independent prescribers, key GPhC learning outcomes related to prescribing will need to be evidenced in the training year. Employers must confirm trainees will have access to a Prescribing Learning Environment, Designated Supervisor and Designated Prescribing Practitioner.
