- Shortage of Salbutamol nebuliser liquid following the Medicines Supply Notification issued on 14th February 2024 reporting a shortage of salbutamol nebuliser liquid in 2.5mg/2.5ml and 5mg/2.5ml strengths, providers have been advised to liaise with local pharmacy teams and urgently order unlicensed imports, transition patients off nebulisers, and consider alternative inhalation methods.
